- each individual has a right to be safe, and to be treated with respect and dignity

We shall use our best endeavours to ensure that:

- all allegations of abuse are taken seriously;
- the response to them is swift and appropriate;
- the effectiveness of our policy is reviewed annually;
- a responsible person shall be appointed annually as Child Protection and Vulnerable Adults Officer to whom members can address any concerns
